RE: PASTOR MUKHUBA IS RESTORING HOPE TO THE PEOPLE OF CAPE TOWN

Unity Fellowship Church, of Unity in Blessings Network (UBN) Ministries, was founded and formed by Pastor Mpariseni Mukhuba in 2004 in Soweto, Gauteng. True to its vision on winning souls to the Kingdom of God, the ministry opened its first branch in Bellville, Cape Town in 2016. It is continuing to open other branches in other provinces of SA.

We are excited by the doors that God continues to open for His people through this ministry. Pastor Mukhuba will be handing over a big Auditorium to the people of Phillippi, Cape Town on Saturday, February 26th, 2022 at 11h00. The building of this Auditorium started in 2019 and was completed in 2020, just as the covid-19 pandemic was starting. The opening celebrations were postponed. Things have improved and the country is slowly returning to normal. We invite everyone to come celebrate with us. This church campus is situated in a place where many people do not want to go because of the high rate of crime. It thus demonstrates the love of God which brings hope to the hopeless and the rejected. This is like a light that is shining upon those who were living in darkness.

The Auditorium opening celebration will follow the Anointing services which will be held over two days on February 24th and 25th, 2022, starting at 10h00 in the morning.

The ministry has made great impact across the country and beyond the borders, in the 18 years of its existence. During lockdown, when churches were closed and the government advised people to attend church services online, UBN offered online and virtual services across all its platforms (UBN TV, Facebook, YouTube, UBN App and website).

The ministry offers 24-hour free telephonic counselling services available in many languages. Church offices at head office remain open for walk-in counselling and prayer services. This commitment to serve our congregants and the general public should be enough to earn the church the "essential service" status that is granted to other institutions such as hospitals, etc.

The church contributes significantly to the spiritual, emotional, social and economic development of the community. We have seen people's lives being transformed and changed for better. Many criminals and drug addicts are rehabilitated in the church to become responsible and law-abiding citizens. Through the Pastor Mukhuba Foundation, we have seen many school children from the surrounding areas receiving school shoes and socks.
